As a result of the staff's hard work, we are delighted to announce that we are full in Year 7 and have a number of students on the waiting list.

## Attendance:

I start the year with a refreshed plea for us to continue working together to ensure students attend every day.

Historically, typical national average attendance for secondary age students across the country is 95%.

This equates to each student, across the country, on average, being absent from school **no more than nine days over the course of the whole academic year.** 

Research shows that students who have 100% attendance achieve almost twice as many GCSEs as those students who attend for 94% of the time. Students whose attendance is 90% miss one month of school, equating to 120 lessons each year.
