As the end of the first half term approaches, I write to update you on the great progress that has been made so far this academic year. It has been an extremely busy and successful seven weeks! We have been inundated with visitors who have all commented positively on our calm and quiet learning environment and how hard students work in their lessons. Of course, creating this type of environment and culture takes continuous hard work which our staff demonstrate in abundance on a daily basis.

Please find below updates and reminders which I hope you will find informative and useful.

Attendance

Well done to the many families who support children attending school every day and also to those families who have supported children in improving their attendance so far this year. You will be aware that attendance links closely to academic results. We have carried out our own analysis of this looking at the summer's GCSE results and the conclusion was staggering; students that attended well attained GCSE results that were, on average, more than twice as high than those who attended less well.

We do understand that on occasion, students are too ill to come to school. However, we know that nationally this occurrence is very rare, rather than half termly, for children who do not have underlying medical conditions.

Can I please take this opportunity to remind you that students need to be through the gate by 8.35am in order to be ready to start form time or assembly at 8.40am prompt. We know that sometimes buses are unreliable and that traffic can be unpredictable. Please take account for this with regard to your child's morning schedule. Many children get an 'early bus' and arrive on site from 8am to ensure they're never late.

Half Term 2 Attendance Reward System

To further champion good attendance, we are launching a new rewards system for half term two. For each week that your child has no unauthorised absences and is on time for school, they will receive a token to place into a raffle box. We have three prizes on offer: a £200 bike voucher, a 50" TV and £200 Liverpool One vouchers. The more tokens your child has, the more chance they have of winning. There will also be a £100 food shopping voucher for a parent/carer of a child who has had no unauthorised absences or incidents of lateness during half term two. The competition winners will be announced on the last day of next half term.



ClassCharts

The ClassCharts app (or website) is a way of finding out how your child is doing in school. The school also uses the app as the main way to communicate with students and families on a day-to-day basis. The app will tell you how many positive points your child has and if your child has any poor behaviour and the associated consequences.
