Dear Parent / Carer,

As of September 2021, the school made the decision to allow students to arrive at school in their PE Kit on days that they have PE. This decision was made to ensure that students weren't getting changed in close proximity to each other when national Covid restrictions were stricter.

Whilst the vast majority of students have complied with both PE kit rules as well as wearing kit on the correct days, unfortunately, a considerable number of Year 11 students are choosing to arrive to school on PE days in clothes not appropriate for PE as well as arriving to school on non-PE days in their kit.

Understandably, this has had an impact on form tutors, pastoral staff, the assistant Head of Year and Head of Year who are having to spend a significant amount of time each morning dealing with these students. This also takes away valuable teaching time and pastoral support from the year group.

Year 11 were informed some time ago, that they needed to comply with the school rules otherwise our decision will be reviewed.

Unfortunately, this warning has not had the impact desired and we continue to have various staff unable to complete their regular duties each day.

As a result, the school has made the following decision:

**From Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022, all Year 11 students are to arrive in full Prescot School uniform every day.**

On PE days, students are to bring their full Prescot School PE kit into school in a bag and change at the beginning of the PE lesson. They will then change back into full school uniform after their PE lesson.

Any student who does not comply will be sent home to change. During this important time of your child's education, we would appreciate your support in ensuring your child is fully aware of, and following the school's rules.
