**Amendment to the Mobile Phone Policy.**

From the new half term, I am amending the mobile phone policy. Mobile phones must not be **seen in school at any time**. Advise your child that phones should be turned off and placed in their bags until they leave the school site at the end of the day.

Below are the sanctions for use of a mobile phones in the school.

RULE BREAK	SANCTION
Mobile phone visible or audible in school.	Phone is confiscated, stored in safe and returned at the end of school day.
Deliberate use of mobile phone in lesson. Example: Texting.	Phone is confiscated, stored in safe and returned at the end of school day + 40-minute same day detention.
Deliberate use of mobile phone at lunch or break.	Phone is confiscated, stored in safe and returned at the end of school day + 40-minute same day detention.
The second time a student breaks one the above rules the phone will be confiscated and will need to be collected by parent/carer.	
If there is a third time a student breaks one of the rules, then they will be required to submit their phone on arrival to school and collect at the end of each day for one week.	

Thank you once again for your ongoing support and commitment to your child's education. I am excited about the progress we've made and look forward to what we will continue to achieve together.
