Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of some important changes we will be implementing to ensure the safety and welfare of our students when travelling to and from school. We have received several concerns from members of our community, families, and students regarding traffic congestion and safety on Knowsley Park Lane during busy periods.

In response, and after careful consideration, we are introducing the following for a trial period, from **Monday 25 November**:

Change 1: Traffic Restrictions on Knowsley Park Lane

To reduce congestion and improve safety, we are **requesting that no cars proceed past Park Road** from Knowsley Park Lane when dropping off or picking up children. Instead, we ask that cars **turn right up Park Road**. This adjustment will help keep the main entrance to the school clear, reducing the risk of accidents and ensuring a safer environment for students and staff. Additionally, using Park Road for exit will prevent the congestion caused by two-way traffic on Knowsley Park Lane.

Change 2: New Pedestrian Exit on Park Road

To further alleviate congestion and increase student safety, we will be **opening the pedestrian gate onto Park Road for 10 minutes only**. This will provide an additional exit route for students at the end of the school day, helping to reduce the number of students using Knowsley Park Lane. We believe this change will ease foot traffic and create a safer environment for everyone.

We kindly remind all drivers to watch their speed when dropping off or picking up children, as many use Knowsley Park Lane, Park Road, Egerton Road, and Stanley Crescent. Please also be considerate of nearby residents during drop-off and pick-up times.

We will communicate these changes to all students and staff, and we kindly ask for your support in following the new traffic arrangements. These measures are being put in place with the safety and wellbeing of our students as the priority, and we hope that you can understand and cooperate with these adjustments.

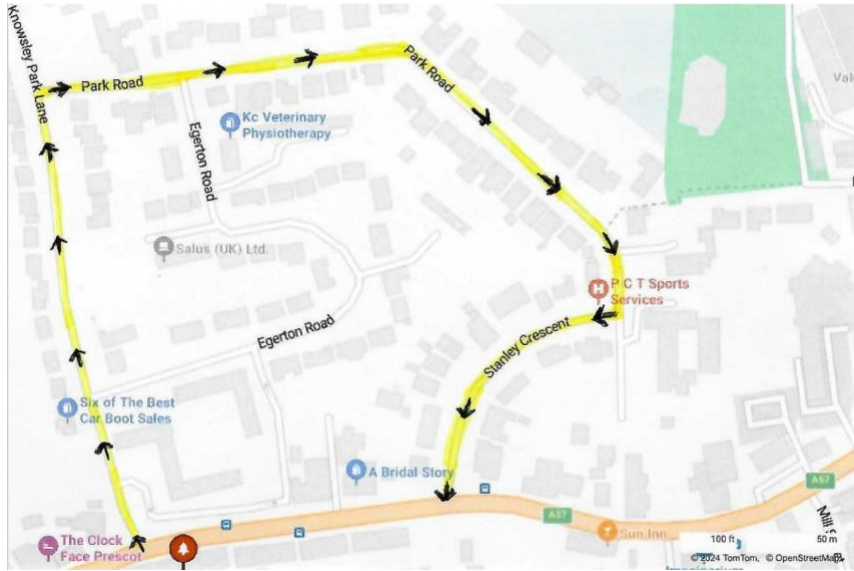
