Merseyside Police Competition Winner

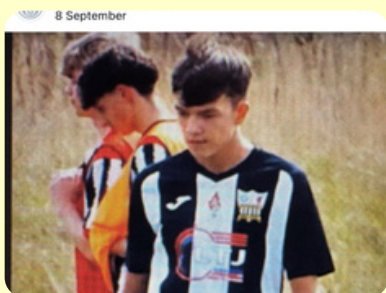

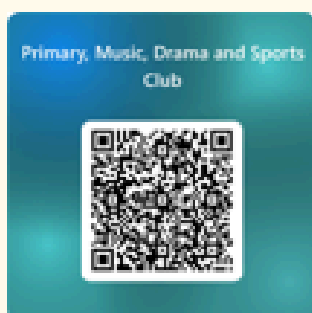
